GUIDELINES/INSTRUCTIONS FOR HOME ASSIGNMENT

For 1st semester DSC

- 1. Students should submit **ONE SINGLE ASSIGNMENT** on 29th Oct. which will contain two topics: one from each paper. The marks allotted for each topic is 20 and thus two topics will contain 20+20=40 marks. Word limit: Maximum 2000 words
- 2. Students SHOULD NOT bring two separate Assignments.
- 3. As it is a part of the final examination, students MUST bring their I- Card/Library Card for verification of identity, without which his/her Assignment will NOT be accepted.

For 3rd Semester DSC

- 4. Students should submit **TWO SEPARATE** write-ups (as small as possible) to be submitted on 30th Oct (DSC 201) and on 31st Oct (DSC 202). **Viva-voce** will be conducted on both the dates after the submission of Assignment by each student. Marks distribution for each paper will be 10 for writing and 10 for the Viva-voce. Word limit for each paper: Maximum 1000 words
- 5. As it is a part of the final examination, students **MUST** bring their **I-Card and Assam University Registration Certificate** for verification of identity, **without which** his/her Assignment will **NOT** be accepted and his/her Viva-voce will **NOT** be conducted.

For 5th Semester DSC
